Who Qualifies for Legal Help?

Whether you qualify for legal help will depend on your monthly income and disposable capital. You can check if you are eligible for Legal Aid by visiting <https://www.gov.uk/check-legal-aid> . Alternatively, you can call us directly on **0121 245 4614**. Should you qualify for Legal Help, you will need to be able to provide evidence in support of your financial circumstances.

Anyone who qualifies for Legal Aid can obtain legal advice and assistance through the Legal Aid Agency's (LAA) Legal Help funding providing the matter falls into the Legal Help scope remit. Mayflower Solicitors has a remit to take on Legal Help clients for certain Housing and Debt Legal matters.

Anyone seeking legal aid for matters of debt, including repossession proceedings arising from mortgage arrears or a forced sale of your property, should firstly contact the CLA Helpline on **0845 345 4345** to confirm your eligibility for face-to-face advice and to obtain a matter reference number before contacting us.

If you are not entitled to Legal Aid, we can also advise you on a private fee paying basis and may also consider reduced rates or 'No Win, No Fee' ('CFA') arrangements for some clients.
